## City sets 31 August deadline to legalise boom gates!

The City of Johannesburg's Transport Department has granted Ward 120 in Lenasia South temporary permission to retain its security boom gates until 31 August 2025.

This comes after sustained efforts by the Boom Gate Committee, led by Jason Reddy, and supported by Ward Councillor Puseletso Nzimande and community members. The City's decision follows a site visit on 23 May and a formal letter on 22 May acknowledging the positive impact of these structures in reducing crime.

The City has given the community three months to submit all documents in line with the 2018 Security Access Restrictions Policy. Failure to comply will lead to gate removals. Reddy stressed the urgency: "All

gates are illegal without formal approval. We must comply by the deadline or risk losing these safety measures." Nine gated communities are currently represented on the committee. Ridwaan Minty, Ward Committee for Safety and Security, urged others to join.

The City and SAPS have reported reduced crime in secured areas. Residents are urged to support the process to maintain safety. A planned meeting to submit applications to the City, originally set for 14 July, has been postponed – a new date is yet to be confirmed.

# JOBURG POWER CRISIS: Almost 100 000 reported outages in 9 months, 5 126 very serious



Power from July 2024 to the end of March 2025. The key finding: serious high-voltage and medium-voltage outages are getting worse as the grid reaches its end of life. As we reported the impact of outages on people's lives, a few trends became clear: citizens and residents are turning to old forms of energy such as paraffin and petrol because solar is still too expensive for most. Business margins of the vital small and medium-sized hustle businesses so important to national growth are

Kabelo, a resident and a student at The Finishing College in Braamfontein who runs a business in Vlakfontein, said: "The power outages are very bad, hey, because literally every time it starts raining, or it rains, or it gets a little windy, the lights go. They are gone for days. It's not a few hours – it's four to six days at a time. Food rots and there's no water to bathe. It's stressful for everybody. Most houses here have gas stoves, or primer stoves that use paraffin and others, light a fire to boil water to bathe or to cook. It's really hard. Imagine getting up in the morning to go and look for wood for a fire. As a student, it's bad, because you have to do schoolwork. "Without WiFi the (mobile phone) towers go down and the network is bad. I can't complete my assignments, so I have to do everything there in Braamfontein and catch late transport back home again."

Africa's powerhouse city is going back to the Dark Ages after decades of post-apartheid electrification gains. A Johannesburg power data investigation by Daily Maverick has found a total of 97 715 reported power

outages in nine months – with more than 5 126 serious enough to take out entire suburbs at once. This is the first independent attempt to put a number on the scale of Johannesburg's power crisis placing South Africa's economic powerhouse at risk. We began tabulating quarterly reports from City

seeing their margins chopped because they must buy expensive inverters and generators to keep going. Many are shutting shop, laying off people or not expanding because they can't afford to hire more staff even where there is demand.



## PETITION

### Residents want Ward 120's Nzimande gone!

Residents of Ward 120 – Lenasia South have launched a petition demanding the immediate removal of Cllr Puseletso Nzimande, citing poor service delivery, lack of communication and disrespectful behaviour. Within two weeks, the petition gained 1 177 signatures. Residents accuse Cllr Nzimande of neglecting essential services such as waste removal, road maintenance and public lighting. They also allege favouritism, racial bias and failure to engage with the community. They are calling on the City to act.

#### Comments from some residents:

Tessa: "She doesn't communicate and is rude when approached. She blocks residents and never addresses the community in a crisis." Dada: "She once told us nothing will be done for Lenasia South because we didn't vote for her. How did she even get this position?" Cindy: "She helps those of her race, but ignored me. My husband has applied for the CPW post several times with no feedback." Residents take to local WhatsApp groups on a daily basis with frustrations against Nzimande.

#### Cllr Nzimande responds:

"I'm aware of the petition and the frustrations from residents but, I face the same issues like power outages and water cuts because I live here too. I've tried my best to assist, I was even at the power station with engineers during the last blackout. It's hurtful to be blamed when I'm also affected. Some residents came to my home, threw tyres and intimidated my family. I had to call the police for protection." Here is the link: <https://chng.it/C8YXjr7Jjy>



**Who doesn't feel like a McDonald's Big Mac Meal now and again? I know, just saying this makes you hungry! Someone may respond and say, "I like one right now."**

Morgan Spurlock, conducted a personal experiment, using himself as a guinea pig for 30 days eating just McDonald's food for breakfast, lunch and supper. Morgan Spurlock gained 25kgs in that 30 days. Side effects will visit you and you may say, "Well, I will go to the doctor." Most times, the root causes are not tackled. Oh yes! The doctor may mention it to you but are you purposefully making adjustments in your eating pattern. Each person must take responsibility for their own health.  
Fast food outlets are readily available, just about wherever you turn. School cafeterias are no more just selling juice, chips and sweets but the fat has been added to their sales as well. Obtaining a Fast-Food Franchise has become much easier now. Uber Eats with their easy-to-use apps and

quick deliveries does not make it a better option to healthy eating. Eating healthy requires time. We often say we don't have time. But isn't this so ironical! Because, when the consequences of bad eating habits attack our bodies, we make time to heal. We take time off work. We can adjust that. Make time to plan your meals. # ARTIFICIAL SWEETENERS

**Allulose, a new sweetener, made from certain fruits, tends to promote a sense of satiety similar to GLP1 like ozempic.** Stevia and monkfruit are another natural sweeteners that will not increase blood insulin levels, but has a somewhat bitter after taste. Aspartame is very sweet and sucralose less sweeter and are both artificial sweetener. Sugar alcohols like xylitol, erythrolol are both natural sweeteners but will increase all blood insulin levels.

This will have the effect of making you feel hungry for mainly starchy foods. Some diet beverages have a combination of aspartame and sucralose. Therefore sweetened drinks need to always be kept minimal. When eating a meal and drinking sweetened drinks, the person will tend to eat more than usual, and get more fatter. Those who consume Allulose tend to make the body burn sugar faster to make energy. This would be similar to burning fat for fuel by making ketones. Allulose also lowers uric acid thus improving gout. Allulose changes how the body breaks down fructose. Allulose is not burnt for fuel. Xylitol and erythrolol, are mostly excreted in the urine. They cause a lot of diarrhea, because they tend to ferment in the gut. Stevia and monkfruit extract do not cause diarrhea. Aspartame has been shown to cause cancer in the bladder when consumed in very high quantities. This would like an adult human being consuming 20 x 2l aspartame containing beverages. Sucralose which is sweeter, can cross into the brain so avoid consuming it. Follow the rules, Consuming carbs should be controlled, prioritise protein and don't fear eating good fats like animal fat, chicken skin, butter, ghee, coconut and olive oil. Exclude not processed foods like grain or rice flour, but rather in the form of vegetables like pumpkin or squash.
